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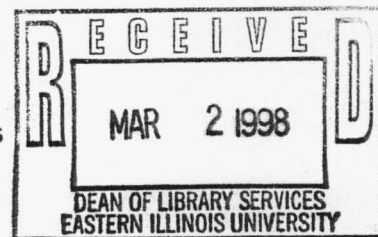

February 23, 1998

Mary Greenlaw called the meeting to order.

The minutes from the January 26, 1998, meeting were approved.

Lynda Kayser presented the new course proposal for EDG 5140 Essentials of Community Agency Counseling. Following discussion, this proposal was approved.

Lynda Kayser presented the curricular change proposal involving the Community Counseling program. Part #1 of this proposal involves replacing the Educational Foundation courses currently required of Community Counseling students with EDG 5140 (Essentials of Community Agency Counseling) and EDG 5721 (Counseling Perspectives on Human Development). The Community Counseling program would then offer an M.S. Degree rather than the current M.S. in Ed. Degree. Following discussion, this proposal was approved.

Part #2 of this proposal involves changing the name of the Department of Educational Psychology and Guidance to Department of Counseling and Student Development in order to more accurately reflect its professional identity. Following discussion, this proposal was approved.

Dean Hitch addressed the committee regarding copy responsibilities. Any copying costs incurred due to curricular changes are departmental responsibilities.

John Weber expressed concern regarding the way the coversheets for course curricular change requests are being used. Many of the requests the committee receives have "see attached" in the "Reason for Request" area of the form. As departments use these forms and find any modifications that might need to be made, please provide this feedback to the committee for consideration.
