CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's Eastern Trio will perform on Tuesday, Feb. 26 at 7:30 p.m. in Dvorak Concert Hall. Included on the program will be Copland's Trio "Vitebsk," Mozart's Trio No. 3 in E Major, K. 542, and Brahms' Trio No. 2 in C. Major, Op. 87. There is no admission charge.

The Trio, in residence at Eastern since its creation in 1981, is composed of violinist Barbara Sturgis-Everett; cellist Donald Tracy; and pianist Karen Larvick Sanders. All are faculty members.

The Trio has performed, adjudicated and conducted clinics for young musicians and teachers throughout Illinois and the midwest. An entire concert was televised in 1983.

This season the Trio is touring with works by Handel, Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, Schubert, Mendelssohn, Brahms, Ravel, Bloch, Martinu and Copland.

Sturgis-Everett studied for five years at the Peabody Conservatory in Baltimore and for three years with members of the LaSalle Quartet at the College-Conservatory of Music in Cincinnati, where she is a candidate for the Doctor of Musical Arts degree.

Tracy studied at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, N.Y., and at the University of Michigan where he obtained the Master of Music degree. He has appeared as a soloist, in chamber groups, and conductor in the midwest and eastern states.

Larvick Sanders studied at Gustavus Adolphus College in Minnesota. She obtained the Master of Music degree at the University of Wisconsin. She has also studied at Tanglewood and the University of Iowa.
