CHARLESTON, IL--A former vice president of the Hollywood (Fla.) Savings and Loan Association, Drayton R. Justus, has been named Director of Human Resources (formerly Personnel and Employee Relations) at Eastern Illinois University. He succeeds Edward Sawtelle.

At the Florida institution, Justus administered all human resource functions, including policy. Prior to that he was the assistant director of personnel at the University of Toledo.

Other positions he has held include recruitment and manpower planning specialist at Owens-Illinois, Inc., Toledo; and personnel director, Jersey City, N.J.

Justus holds a bachelor's degree from Duke University and a master's degree in human resource management from Nova (Fla.) University. He is a member of many professional organizations.

The announcement of Justus' appointment was made by Dr. Verna Armstrong, Vice President for Administration and Finance. She said "Mr. Justus is well-qualified, both by training and experience, for the position. We are pleased that he accepted our offer to join the staff."

Justus is responsible for the total university payroll and for personnel services for approximately 750 non-academic employees with regard to recruitment and employment, benefits, classification, staff development and training, and employee and labor relations.
