CHARLESTON, IL --The second in a series of lectures by members of the "Young Millionaires Club" will be held at Eastern Illinois University on Tuesday, Nov. 11 at 7 p.m. in Coleman Hall Room 120.

James P. Liautaud, president and founder of Capsonic Group, Inc., will be the speaker. Admission for non-members of the student group, the Society for Advancement of Management, is \$3.

Liautaud, a University of Illinois graduate, founded the company to utilize newly-developed plastic materials and techniques for molding metal into plastic for the electronic and computer industries.

Delaware corporations he has founded include American Antenna, Inc., K40 Electronics, Inc., and CECOP, Inc.

He is the holder of more than 20 patents and several more are pending and his articles have been published in more than 50 magazines.
