CHARLESTON, IL--The editor-in-chief of Volume 1, Number 1 of a library journal with international subscriptions will be Dr. Wilson Luquire, Dean of Library Services at Eastern Illinois University.

The journal, published by the Haworth Press of New York, will disseminate the latest developments and trends in resource sharing among all types of libraries.

Title of the New publication, to be published on a quarterly basis, is "Resource Sharing and Information Networks: Technology to Promote Cooperative Library Services" (RESIN).

Luquire said RESIN "is concerned with both the theoretical and practical application of networking." The first issue will include in-depth coverage of a symposium, "Networking: Where to From Here?" in Champaign on April 12.

The symposium will be chaired by Luquire. Haworth executives offered the editorship of the journal to Luquire after seeing his organization of the symposium. Speakers will include executive directors of the major library networks in the nation. Jim Edgar, Secretary of State and State Librarian of Illinois, will also be on the program.

Luquire said "RESIN, as the acronym implies, represents a binding or linking together of information systems and libraries. Aim of the journal is to provide a forum for ideas on the basic theoretical and practical problems faced by planners, practitioners and users of network services."

Editorial associates and editorial assistants will be named from faculty and support staff at Eastern, Luquire said.
