EIU CELEBRATES AFRICAN AMERICAN HERITAGE WITH DINNER AND CONCERT

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University's on-going six-week African American Heritage Celebration will feature a dinner and concert on Sunday, Feb. 9, in the Martin Luther King Jr. University Union Grand Ballroom.

The evening will begin at 5 p.m. with cocktails, followed by dinner at 6. The menu consists of fried chicken; roasted chicken; fried catfish; mixed greens; red beans and rice; sweet potatoes; corn bread; mustard potato salad; fruit salad; chocolate, yellow and German cakes; and coffee, iced tea and ice water.

The university's Unity Gospel Choir, comprised of Eastern students, will perform at 7 p.m.

Open to all campus and community members and friends, the event is \$12 for adults and \$5 for students with ID. Tickets must be purchased by 3 p.m. Friday at the University Union Box Office.
