An updated curriculum flow chart was distributed. Committee members were asked to insert it in their curriculum notebooks for reference.

Lillian Greathouse presented a merger proposal, including one new course proposal, needed for a Career and Technical Education program. The new course proposal was CTE 3100-3, Instructional Technology in Career and Technical Education. The resulting new curriculum was presented. The following courses require a prefix change to CTE: BED/FCS/INT 2000, BED/FCS/INT 3400, BED 3401, BED 3402, FCS 3403, INT 3404, BED/FCS/INT 4913, and BED/FCS/INT 4923. Proposals for minors in each of the three emphases (business education, family and consumer sciences education, and technology education) were presented. Following discussion, the entire proposal was approved.
