Dolin, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Terry Dolan of Catlin, is a 1987 graduate of Schlarman High School, Danville.

He is president of Gamma Theta Upsilon national geography society, vice-president of the Geoscience Club, a member of Sigma Gamma Epsilon geology/earth science national honor society and recipient of the 1988 Geology Alumni Award for Outstanding Service.

Since their inception in 1977, the Warner Presidential Awards have gone to 168 outstanding Eastern juniors, seniors and graduate students in 17 different academic areas.
