# Dewey Connor, Jr., At Great Lakes Station

*July 16, 1942*

Great Lakes, Ill.—From civilian, to “boot”, to Bluejacket, is the transition that Dewey Ross Connor Jr., of Newton, Ill., is now undergoing at the U. S. Naval Training Station here, since he reported for duty last week. After he finishes his boot (recruit) training, the new recruit will either be assigned abroad a Navy Man-O-War, or held for further specialized training at one of the Navy's many service schools.
