CHARLESTON, IL--The Eastern Illinois University Concert Choir, Cecilian Singers, and Mixed Chorus will present a concert on Tuesday, March 2 at 8 p.m. in the Dvorak Concert Hall.

Dr. John N. Maharg will direct the Mixed Chorus in the opening group of choral pieces that will include "Tenebrae factae sunt" by Palestrina, "Three Gypsy Songs" by Brahms, and "Deep River" arranged by Ringwald.

Dr. James M. Brinkman will lead the Cecilians in "Laudate Pueri" by Michael Haydn, "Coffee Grows on White Oak Trees," and Butler's "Willow, Willow."

Dr. Robert E. Snyder will conduct the Concert Choir in "Tu es Petrus" by Palestrina, "The Falcon" by Gerrish, "All Breathing Life" by J.S. Bach, and Erb's arrangement of "Shenandoah."

The concert is free and open to the public.

The EIU Concert Choir will be one of six choirs to sing in the 14th Annual American Choral Directors Association Illinois Invitational College Choir Festival on Saturday, Feb. 27 in Smith Hall at the University of Illinois.
