LULICH NAMED WARNER SCHOLAR

CHARLESTON, IL.--Ronald Lulich, whose parents, Mr. and Mrs. Robert Lulich, live in Thornton, is the recipient of Eastern Illinois University's Errett and Mazie Warner Presidential Award in Botany.

Lulich, a senior Botany/Environmental Biology major, is a 1984 graduate of Thornwood High School, South Holland.

He is president of Eastern's Botany Club, vice-president of Phi Sigma Honorary Society and the 1989 recipient of the Ernest L. Stover Scholarship in Botany.

Since their inception in 1977, the Warner Presidential Awards have gone to 168 outstanding Eastern juniors, seniors and graduate students in 17 different academic areas.

The late Mr. Warner, a 1925 Eastern graduate, established a permanent endowment fund in 1976 to continue the scholarships. His estate will provide more than \$750,000 in cash and farm land for the endowment fund.
