CHARLESTON, IL--Introduction to Microcomputers, an Eastern Illinois University Community Business Assistance Center (CBAC) program, will be held from 9 a.m.-Noon on Saturday, February 15 in Room 304 of EIU's Old Main.

Co-sponsored by the Small Business Administration and the Charleston Area Chamber of Commerce, this workshop will be an introduction to IBM personal computers.

No previous experience is necessary, according to Dr. Terry Maris, Assistant Dean of the EIU College of Business. "Each participant, though, needs to supply a 5¼ inch, double-sided, double-density floppy disk."

Instructors will be Laura Rao, EIU associate professor of library services and instructor of data processing in the college of business, and Paul Rao, professor and head of information systems at Booth Library.
