CHARLESTON -- Two Eastern Illinois University faculty, Mary Anne Hanner of Oakland and Gail J. Richard of Charleston, and a 1979 EIU alumnus, Joanne E. Schupbach of Westmont, have been named 1996 Fellows of the Illinois Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ISHA).

ISHA Fellowships are given to individuals who have demonstrated consistent excellence in at least three areas of achievement.

Hanner was recognized for her record of clinical service as a public school speech-language pathologist and as a clinical supervisor at EIU. She also was recognized for her administrative excellence as director of the EIU Speech-Language-Hearing Clinic and for her extensive contributions to ISHA.

Richard was recognized for her record of clinical service, in particular, her work with children with autism. She also was cited for her teaching excellence and service to ISHA.
