HANNER AND RICHARD COMPLETE TWO PUBLICATIONS

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University communication disorders and sciences faculty members Gail Richard of Charleston and Mary Anne Hanner of Oakland recently published the second editions of two earlier publications.

The Language Processing Test - Revised is used by speech-language pathologists and education teachers to diagnose language processing disorders in students who are 5 to 11 years of age. The LPT-R is a comprehensive revision of an earlier version published in 1985. The revised test was re-standardized on a national sample.

The Language Processing Kit is a remediation program designed for use with students who have a language processing disorder. The LP Kit was developed through a re-design of a book published in 1987, Language Processing Remediation. LinguiSystems, Inc. of East Moline is the publisher.

Hanner and Richard are licensed speech-language pathologists and hold the Certificate of Clinical Competence from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association. Richard was a speech-language pathologist in the Iowa public schools
