**HEARD FROM PRIVATE** *Aug. 28,*  
**ELMER ERWIN IN JAPAN** *1945*

Mr. and Mrs. Emmitt Erwin were week end guests of his daughter, Mrs. Orville Cummins and family of near Newton. He was employed at the Green River ordnance plant at Dixon until it closed down last week.

Mr. Erwin recently heard from his son, Private Elmer Erwin, who is a prisoner of war in Japan. When he cabled he was in good health, he stated. He was captured at the fall of Corregidor in May, 1942.

Mr. and Mrs. Erwin are leaving Wednesday for Franklin county near Sessor, where they will reside on her farm.
