March 27, 2000

Judith Lyles called the meeting to order.

The minutes from the February 28, 2000, meeting were approved.

Barbara Powell presented a course change proposal from the Department of Counseling and Student Development to revise EDP 3325 Educational Psychology. The main points of revision that are being proposed are to change the course number and title to EDP 3331 Theories of Learning and Development for Secondary Teachers, to add a lab component, to increase clock hours of participation from 15 to 30, and to require concurrent enrollment with SED 3330. Following discussion, this proposal was approved to become effective Fall 2001.

Julie Dietz presented four items from the Department of Health Studies. The first item was a curricular change request to change the number of electives hours required for the Health Studies major with the Community Health option from 9 semester hours to 8-9 semester hours. Following discussion, this proposal was approved to become effective Fall 2000.

The second item Dr. Dietz presented was a new course proposal for HST 1600G Health and Human Behavior. Following discussion, this proposal was approved to become effective Fall 2001.

The third item Dr. Dietz presented was a proposal to revise HST 2600. The revisions to this course include changing the number and title to HST 2600G Global Health Issues. Following discussion, this proposal was approved to become effective Fall 2001.

The last item Dr. Dietz presented was a proposal to revise EIU 4047G. The course is being revised to accommodate the changes to General Education by making this a 3 s.h. course. Following discussion, this proposal was approved to become effective Spring 2001.

It is now a requirement that all CAA agenda items be submitted both electronically and in hard-copy format. Therefore, all departments should continue to submit curricular items as they presently do plus send an electronic version to Bonnie Wilson. The electronic version must be in Word or Word Perfect format.

Due to the anticipated number of curricular items for our next meeting, it was decided to begin the April 24 meeting at 2:00 p.m. instead of 2:30 p.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:27 p.m.
