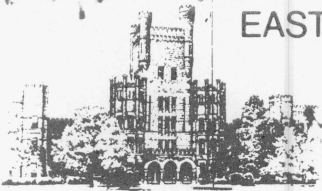

CHARLESTON, IL.--Twenty-five Eastern Illinois University faculty members have been awarded tenure, effective Fall Semester 1990.

Tenure is a status awarded by the Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities upon the positive recommendation of the University President following an extensive evaluation process.

It is a relationship of continuing commitment between the University and the employee benefitting both. Each tenured employee shall have continuous employment at the University unless he or she resigns, retires, is laid off or terminated for adequate cause.
