CHARLESTON, IL --An "artsbreaking" ceremony, signalling the formal beginning of the Tarble Arts Center construction, will be held on Tuesday, March 24, at 4 p.m. at the site south of the Buzzard Education Building, Eastern Illinois University.

Instead of the ceremonial earth turning with a shovel, persons closely connected with the fund campaign will sign a large board bearing a likeness of the building and the letters "TAC." The board will then be kept as a memento of the event.

Among officials scheduled to participate are President Daniel E. Marvin, Jr., Dr. Vaughn Jaenike, Dean of the School of Fine Arts; Don Carmichael, Tarble Arts Center Director; and Aubert North, Chairman of the Campaign Cabinet.

The ceremony is open to the public.
