CHARLESTON, IL--School finance and recent court decisions, as well as perspectives on what Illinois school administrators are "doing right" will be among topics discussed at the meeting of the Eastern Illinois University Round Table, February 21, at 9:30 a.m. until 1:15 p.m. at Boomer's restaurant in Charleston.

Dr. Jerry Parker, superintendent of Pekin Public School District 108, and luncheon speaker will offer a positive perspective on what Illinois administrators are "doing right."

Dr. Jim Ward, Professor of Educational Finance at University of Illinois, will discuss his perspectives on where Illinois is going as to formula, legislation and dollars for education.
