**HELPED WIN
ARMY-NAVY E**

Feb. 6, 1945

Mrs. Millard E. Flynn of Willow Hill was one of a group of workers at the Green River Ordnance plant at Dixon who helped to win the Army-Navy E, recently awarded the plant. Her group surpassed all previous records for loading rifle grenades by nearly 1,000 projectiles.

In a letter to the Press enclosing a copy of the Green River News, she says: "I'm really proud at my age to be able to be rated as a pace setter, especially at a worth while job. We load rifle grenades. I hope it will not be long until this is history and we can come home to dear old Jasper county."
