CHARLESTON, IL--The Eastern Illinois University Dancers will perform a variety of jazz, modern, and ballet numbers on Friday and Sunday, April 8 and 10 at 8 p.m. in Dvorak Concert Hall.

"...And Then There Was Dance" includes 16 dances, choreographed by members of the club and its adviser, Nancy Nordtvedt.

Lisa Maday, a club member, said many of the dances "deal with the creation of life on earth along with the elements of earth and man's origin."

Choreographer Sherri Smith created two dances relating to the theme. One involves matter as it turns into form and the other illustrates caveman, titled "Toiora."

Another club member, Anne Frick, said "many key members from last year's show are returning. They have worked hard and shown a great deal of improvement."

Tickets, priced at \$2 for the general public and \$1.25 for students, will be on sale in the University Union during the week of the performance, and at the door.

Throughout April, the EIU Dancers will perform at elementary and high schools in Illinois.
