CHARLESTON, IL --Theme of summer school at Eastern Illinois University will be "Perspectives on an Interdependent World," according to Dr. Charles Switzer, Director.

Class dates are May 18-June 11 for the intersession; June 17-July 21 for the five-week session; and June 17-Aug. 6 for the eight-week term.

Dates for intersession registration are May 1 and May 18; for the five-week session, June 15-16; and for the eight weeks, June 15-16. Commencement is Aug. 9.

Distinguished visiting faculty workshops will be among highlights of summer school '81. Two of the visitors--Dr. George K. Schweitzer and Dr. Paul S. Fardy--will conduct two-week sessions.

Holding one-week workshops will be Dr. Gretchen Hieronymus Beall, Dr. Emile J. Talbot, and Most Reverend Edward W. O'Rourke.

Schweitzer, Distinguished Alumni Professor of Chemistry at the University of Tennessee-Knoxville, will be on campus June 22-July 2. One course will consider science and technology and their relationship to social, moral, and religious values. The second will examine the evolving universe from scientific, social, philosophic, religious and futuristic perspectives.

Fardy is Director of Cardiac Rehabilitation and Physical Fitness Center, St. Catherine Hospital, East Chicago, Ind. Dates of his workshop in that area are June 1-10.

Beall, Professor of Music at the University of Colorado, will teach a workshop on a pragmatic approach to music instruction July 6-9.

Talbot is an Associate Professor of French at the University of Illinois. His July 13-16 workshop will be on the difficulties of political union among culturally diverse peoples.

Rev. O'Rourke, Bishop of the Peoria Diocese, will conduct a July 27-30 workshop on self-help in third world countries.
