CHARLESTON, IL--The fourth program in the 1983-84 Chamber Music Series at Eastern Illinois University will feature members of Eastern's Music Department.

Four chamber works will be presented in the Tarble Arts Center on Sunday, March 18 at 3 p.m. Included will be the "Concerto in D Minor for Violin, Oboe and String Orchestra." Joseph Martin, oboe, and Barbara Sturgis-Everett, violin, will perform the work with the Chamber Orchestra, directed by Gary Zwicky.

Two works by the American composer Charles Griffes will be featured. "Poem" will be performed by Robert C. Snyder, flute, and George Sanders, piano. "Five Poems of Ancient China" will be performed by June Johnson, voice, and Sanders.

"Luna" is by Peter Hesterman, instructor of music composition. This work was performed in early March at Notre Dame University. It is written for 12 instruments. The Chamber Orchestra will be conducted by Donald Tracy.

Tickets may be purchased at the door and are priced at \$2.50 for adults and \$1 for students.
