CHARLESTON, IL--Karen Vogt, Waterloo, is a cast member in Eastern Illinois University's production of "Seduced," one of six plays in the nation selected for presentation at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington.

"Seduced" was chosen by the American College Theatre Festival for the Kennedy Center appearance following a regional competition at the University of Illinois.

The drama portrays the last bizarre day in the life of a Howard Hughes-like figure, and is described by the Center as "featuring tour de force performances by the young actors."

The play opens on April 28 at 7:30 p.m. in the Center's Terrace Theatre and will be given on April 29 at 2 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.

Miss Vogt, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Vogt, is a junior theatre arts major. She is a 1979 graduate of Waterloo High School.

Senator and Mrs. Charles Percy are among dignitaries planning to attend the opening performance. The entire Illinois congressional delegation has been invited.
