COLLINS RECEIVES ART AWARDS

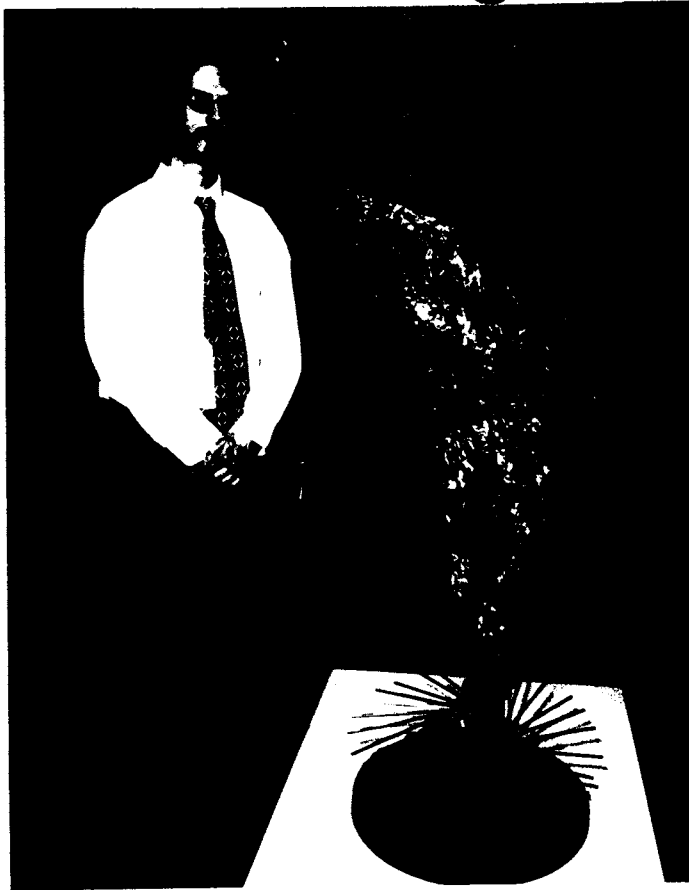
CHARLESTON -- Dylan Ethan Collins, son of David A. and Mary Joan Collins of Charleston, was recently awarded a Paul T. Sargent Award and an Outstanding Senior Award in Studio 3-D at Eastern Illinois University's 1996 All-Student Show.

The Sargent award is given to an art major who has demonstrated exceptional abilities as a visual artist.

The senior award is awarded to an outstanding senior by the faculty in the area of studio 3-D.

The show is an annual juried exhibition open to current Eastern undergraduate students who have enrolled in at least one studio art course. Traditionally, works in a wide variety of media and styles are included. All works must be original, completed within the last two years at Eastern, and not previously exhibited at the Tarble Arts Center.

A 1992 graduate of Charleston High School, Collins is an art studio 2-D major.
