CHARLESTON, IL--Nancy Slusser, Wauconda, is a featured cast member in Eastern Illinois University's production of "Seduced," one of six plays in the nation selected for presentation at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C.

The American College Theatre Festival chose the play following a regional competition at the University of Illinois' Krannert Center.
