EIU SEEKS COMMUNITY MEMBERS TO HELP PLAN HOMECOMING PARADE

CHARLESTON -- In an effort to increase community participation in Eastern Illinois University's annual homecoming parade, applications are being accepted from community members willing to co-serve with students on a parade committee.
