CEPS 02-08, Revisions to the Early Childhood Major

Dr. Carol Helwig presented the proposal to revise this major. Following discussion, it was decided to postpone voting on this proposal for two weeks to allow the Department of Secondary Education and Foundations to review the proposal. The Department of Secondary Education and Foundations was asked to submit their review in writing to the Committee.

CEPS 02-09, Revisions to the Elementary Education Major

Dr. Helwig presented the proposal to revise this major. Following discussion, this proposal was approved.

CEPS 02-10, Proposed Changes for Granting of Credit for the Student Teaching Experience

Dr. Kathlene Shank presented the proposal. Following discussion, this proposal was approved.

CEPS 02-11, Executive Action, Revision to Special Education Courses

Dr. Shank presented the proposal to revise the catalog descriptions for several Special Education courses (SPE 3000, 3200, 3201, 3220, 3250, 3260, 3270, 3500, 3600, 3700, 4530, 4600, 4700, 4720, 4730, 4765, 4800, 4820, 4900, 4901, 4920, 4925, 4950, 4960, and 4970). Two courses will be deleted (SPE 3225 and 4961). Changes to SPE 4900 and 4901 also include changes in the number of credits. Changes to SPE 3700 also include a change in the distribution of hours. Following discussion, this proposal was approved.
