"VOICE AND VISIONS: EIU 1895-1995" EXHIBIT TO OPEN

CHARLESTON -- The Historical Administration Program at Eastern Illinois University and the Coles County Historical Society announce the opening of this year's exhibit, "Voices and Visions: Eastern Illinois University, 1895-1995."
