CHARLESTON, Ill.--More than 70 exhibits will be a feature of Women's Expo and Health Fair '87 at Eastern Illinois University on Saturday, March 7, according to Dr. Joan Schmidt, Eastern faculty member and chair of the exhibit committee.

Information on health concerns, businesses, clubs and organizations, services, education and the arts will be available in the exhibit area.

Women attending will be introduced to a variety of health information, including cancer, heart, alcoholism and drugs, fitness, the hospice program, dental health, visiting nurse programs and hospital services.

Volunteer service organizations dealing with domestic violence, right to life, women against rape, and chemical dependency programs will be represented.

Homemakers will find information provided by pork producers, dairy council, corn marketing board and vegetable growers. Information on continuing education will be provided by colleges, libraries and private companies. Exhibits of arts and crafts will also be displayed.

"With the wide variety of information available, every woman attending should find information of value to them and to their community as they visit the exhibit area," Schmidt said.
