INADA RECEIVES ART AWARD

CHARLESTON -- Maki Inada, daughter of Tomoyoshi Inada and Hiroko Inada of Yokohama, Japan, was recently awarded a Merit Award in Design at Eastern Illinois University's 1996 All-Student Show.

Merit awards are selected in the media categories of drawing, printmaking, painting, graphic design, crafts, sculpture, photography and design.

The show is an annual juried exhibition open to current Eastern undergraduate students who have enrolled in at least one studio art course. Traditionally, works in a wide variety of media and styles are included. All works must be original, completed within the last two years at Eastern, and not previously exhibited at the Tarble Arts Center.

A 1992 graduate of Seiwagakuin High School in Japan, Inada is a junior 2-D art studio major.

Eastern, located in Charleston, is a public, residential university that places priority on teaching excellence. More than 11,000 students are enrolled in
