NETHERTON RECEIVES ART AWARDS

CHARLESTON -- Carey Netherton, son of Larry and Laura Netherton of Sullivan, was recently awarded the Chairman's Award and Best-of-Show Award at Eastern Illinois University's 1996 All-Student Show.

The Chairman's award is awarded by the art faculty to a senior who is exhibiting in the art show and demonstrates exceptional abilities as a visual artist.

The Best-of-Show award is co-sponsored by the Tarble Arts Center and the Art Department, and partially funded through Tarble Arts Center membership contributions. The award is presented by the jurors to the student whose art work was deemed Best-of-Show.

The show is an annual juried exhibition open to current Eastern undergraduate students who have enrolled in at least one studio art course. Traditionally, works in a wide variety of media and styles are included. All works must be original, completed within the last two years at Eastern, and not previously exhibited at the Tarble Arts Center.
