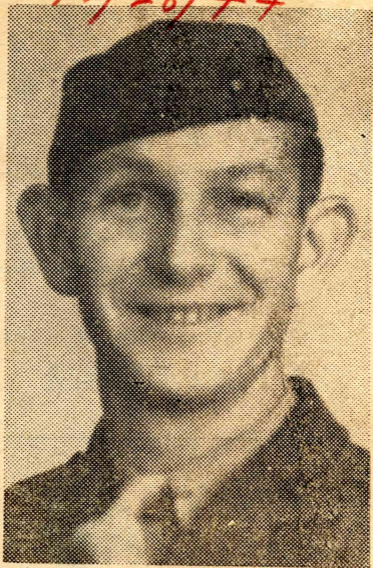

Corporal Clem D. Brinson, of Willow Hill has arrived back in the United States after three years in the service, much of which time has been spent in the Pacific Island hopping of the U. S. Marines. He is expected home within a few days for a visit with his family.

Corp. Brinson was awarded the Purple Heart Medal for wounds received in the battle of Tarawa while serving with the second Marine Corps second amphibian tractor batallion.
