

Minimum of eight (8) s.h. in a preschool special education classroom and eight (8) s.h. in an LBS I setting; credit in student teaching reflects successful completion of student teaching, obtaining passing scores on the Illinois Learning Behavior Specialist I Content Area Test; and obtaining passing scores on the Praxis tests: IGC, IIC, and Common Core.

Page 140, Column 2, Footnote 4 under Early Childhood Option:

4 Credit in student teaching reflects successful completion of student teaching, obtaining passing scores on the Illinois Behavior Specialist I Content Area Test; and, as of Fall 2005, obtaining passing scores on the Praxis Tests: ICG, IIC, and Common Core. As of Fall 2004, the State of Illinois requires that the Special Education LBS I Test be passed prior to commencement of student teaching.
