CHARLESTON, IL--"Can We Hope For A Year 2000?" is the title of a lecture scheduled for Wednesday, April 4 at 7:30 p.m. in the Booth Library Lecture Room, Eastern Illinois University.

The speaker will be Dr. George K. Schweitzer, Alumni Distinguished Professor of Chemistry at the University of Tennessee and a visiting professor at Eastern in 1981 and 1983.

Schweitzer's lecture is the opening program of a month-long series of events, "Toward 2000 Inaugural Symposium," in observance of the inauguration of Dr. Stanley Rives as the sixth president of Eastern on May 12.

Schweitzer is a prominent scientist/philosopher and the holder of doctorates in chemistry, philosophy, and the history of science. He has a master's degree in religion.
