Newton Soldier Wounded In Battle In France

Dec. 28 - 44

Mr. and Mrs. Josiah Jourdan have received notice from the War Department to the effect that their son Woodrow was wounded in action in France on December 4. The extent of his injuries are unknown.

Woodrow arrived at an overseas port on October 28 and has probably been in some of the bitter fighting against the Nazis.
