REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Oct. 3-4)

FOOTBALL: Jeff Christensen (Gibson City) came off the bench to throw three touchdown passes in the fourth quarter sparking the Panthers to a 31-14 victory over Division IA Illinois State. Rod Slaughter (Detroit, MI) had his best day at fullback with 100 yards rushing and 78 yards in pass receiving. Scott McGhee (Palos Heights) had a 40 yard TD pass reception to boost his season total to eight. Mike Cox (Chicago-Prosser/Wright JC) was the defensive standout with 13 tackles and a blocked pass from his defensive end position.

MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY: The Panthers placed eighth in the Notre Dame Invitational paced by Larry Schuldt (Rock Falls) who was 36th out of 140 runners. Terry Donahue (Downers Grove-Montini) was 45th, Chuck Elliott (Palatine) was 48th, Jase Travis (Bradley-Bourbonnais) was 52nd and Tim Warneke (Park Forest-Crete-Monee) was 56th.

SOCCER: EIU took second in the Governor's Cup classic losing 3-0 in the championship to the defending NCAA Division I champ, SIU-Edwardsville. Friday the Panthers downed Western Illinois, 2-0, behind the scoring of Marty Dooley and Gordie Weidle. Eastern is now 6-2.

VOLLEYBALL: EIU was second in the Missouri-St. Louis tournament losing to Iowa State in the finals. EIU downed Illinois Benedictine, UMSL, Dayton and Northeast Missouri to advance to the championship tilt.

TENNIS: Competing in the Millikin Tournament, the Panthers failed to advance anyone to the finals. Jill Anderson (Park Forest-Rich East) was defeated in the quarter-finals.
