CHARLESTON, IL--The Annual Regional "TEAMS" Competition was conducted at Eastern Illinois University Saturday (February 25).

"TEAMS" is an acronym for "Tests in Engineering Aptitude, Mathematics, and Science", and the event is sponsored by the National Professional Society of Engineers.

Twenty-nine area high schools, who had winners at the District level of the competition, participated at Eastern, with similar Regional Competitions at seven other Universities in Illinois.

"TEAMS" WINNERS ANNOUNCED

Winners from the eight Regional Competitions advance to the State level of Competition, to be held at the University of Illinois on March 22 and March 23. Comparative scores at all of the State Competitions will be used to crown a National Champion.

The Competition is conducted in two divisions, Class A and Class AA, according to the enrollment of the High Schools. The winning teams, at Eastern, by class, were:

Class AA

1st Place ----- University High School; Urbana, IL  
2nd Place ----- Urbana High School; Urbana, IL  
3rd Place ----- Eisenhower High School; Decatur, IL

Class A

1st Place ----- Argenta-Oreana High School; Argenta, IL  
2nd Place ----- Altamont High School; Altamont, IL  
3rd Place ----- Clinton High School
