TREICHEL NAMED CHAPTER HONOREE

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University graduate Janet Treichel has been named Eastern Illinois University's Beta Gamma Sigma Chapter Honoree.

The award is given to individuals who have furthered the ideals of the society through outstanding business and managerial leadership.

Treichel, who lives in Herndon, Va., is the daughter of Harriet Metcalf of Charleston and the late Don Metcalf, former chief engineer at Eastern.

She began her career as secretary to the dean of EIU's School of Business and later taught adult education courses in business education at Charleston High School and was on the staff of The Center for Educational Studies in Eastern's School of Education.

In her current position, she manages the national headquarters for The National Business Education Association, one of the nation's largest professional associations dedicated to instruction, administration, research, and dissemination of information for and about business.

She has conducted numerous inservice training workshops for staff in secondary and postsecondary schools and been a consultant to state departments of education and other agencies in the areas of vocational education, business education, career development and occupational analysis.

Treichel earned bachelor's and master's degrees in education from Eastern in 1964 and 1971, respectively. Both were in business education. She also holds a doctorate in education, with an emphasis on vocational education, from the University of Illinois.

She was named Eastern's 1993 Lumpkin College of Business and Applied Sciences' Distinguished Alumnus.
