PANEL DISCUSSION TO EXAMINE "AFTERMATH OF THE VERDICT"

CHARLESTON -- "Aftermath of the Verdict: Where Do We Go From Here?" will be the topic of a panel discussion at 7 p.m. Thursday, April 3, in Lumpkin Hall, room 122, on the Eastern Illinois University campus.

Panelists include the Rev. Dale Beck, Wesley United Methodist Church; Angela Kallis, executive director of the Coalition Against Domestic Violence; Doug Stamps, CADV legal advocate; Annette Samuels, assistant professor of journalism; and Michael Stokes, assistant director of Student Housing. Jeffrey Lynch, associate dean of the College of Arts and Humanities, will be moderator.

Panel members will discuss a variety of issues, including poverty and justice, gender issues, domestic violence, racial tension, impact of the media, justice and mercy, and the impact on individuals, families and society. Panel discussion will focus on the future and "where do we go from here?"
