CHARLESTON, IL--Approximately 200 public high school principals and teachers who cooperate in Eastern Illinois University's teacher preparation program will attend a recognition dinner and conference on Tuesday, April 10.

Six hundred student teachers have been assigned to 115 classrooms in 55 downstate communities and in the Chicago area for their practical experience.

Dr. Francis Summers, Chairman of the Department of Student Teaching, said cooperating principals and teachers are those who accept Eastern's students in their classrooms for up to a full semester. They supervise their teaching, indoctrinate them into the profession and evaluate the performances.

Also attending the dinner will be student teaching coordinators, department chairpersons and other Eastern officials. The dinner begins at 6 p.m. in the Grand Ballroom of the University Union.
