CHARLESTON, IL--A faculty cello recital is scheduled for Thursday, April 2, 7:30 p.m. in Dvorak Concert Hall, Eastern Illinois University. Donald Tracy, cellist, and Gretchen Tracy, pianist, will open the program with the Sonata in A Major, Op. 69, by Beethoven.

The second half of the program will consist of ethnic music, beginning with the Rhapsody of Bela Bartok, based on Hungarian music. Next will be two Hebrew works with Prayer by Bloch and Kol Nidrei of Bruch.

Two Spanish works by De Falla, the lullaby Nana and the Introduction and Millers Dance from "The Three Cornered Hat," will close the recital. The concert is open to the public without charge.
