MCCOY HONORED

CHARLESTON, IL--Sherry McCoy, whose parents, Mr. and Mrs. Maurice McCoy, live in Martinsville, has been awarded the Delta Mu Delta Senior Achievement Award, the Boatmen's National Bank of Charleston Finance Achievement Award, the Lumpkin College of Business Dean's Award, the Phi Gamma Nu Scholarship, and the Delta Sigma Pi Scholarship Key Award at Eastern Illinois University.

The Delta Mu Delta Senior Achievement Award is given to the senior with the highest grade point average in the Lumpkin College of Business.

The Boatmen's Finance Achievement Award is given to the graduating senior in Finance who offers the greatest promise of a career in Finance, and who has an outstanding academic record.

The Lumpkin College of Business Dean's Award is awarded annually to a senior student who has completed 30 semester hours at Eastern Illinois University and has a grade point average of at least 3.2 at the end of semester preceding the term of selection.

The Phi Gamma Nu Scholarship is given to the person with the highest grade point average in the Lumpkin College of Business, who has attended Eastern Illinois University for all four years, and has shown leadership and active involvement in extra-curricular activities.

The Delta Sigma Pi Scholarship Key Award is given to the graduating senior member with the highest grade point average who is enrolled in the Lumpkin College of Business.

McCoy, a 1986 graduate of Martinsville Community High School, is a senior majoring in Accounting and Finance. McCoy has also received the Livingston C. Lord Scholarship, the Hobart F. Heller Scholarship, and the Delta Mu Delta Scholarship.
