**REVISION IN FCS IN BUSINESS OPTION, CONSUMER AFFAIRS CONCENTRATION**

Jean Dilworth presented a program change in the FCS in Business Option, Consumer Affairs concentration, effective Fall 2005. The change adds FCS 3245, Textiles: Color Design Production, to the list of courses from which consumer affairs concentration students are to select 15 hours. The Lectra software donation provides opportunities for students to learn digital textile printing for architectural signage, retail interior signage, carpeting, wall coverings, trade show booths, and apparel, with knowledge about both design and the interaction of inks, dyes, pigments and textile fiber products.
