Army Citation Given Pvt. Tony Passalacqua

Word has been received by his wife, that Pvt. Anthony Passalacqua has received the citation award of the Meritorious Service Unit Plaque for superior performance of duty in the execution of exceptionally difficult tasks during the period of July 1, 19-44 to September 15, 1944.

The citation was awarded to the 349th Engineering Group stationed in

the Aleutian Islands.
