ELECTION OF CHAIR/VICE-CHAIR

Jean Dilworth was elected Chair and Thomas Hawkins was elected Vice-Chair for 2004-2005 by acclamation.

MEETING TIME FOR FUTURE MEETINGS

For 2004-2005, the committee expressed their first preference of meeting times as the third Tuesday of each month from 2:00-3:00 and their second preference as Mondays from 11:00-12:00. The Dean will ask the Dean's Student Advisory Board members to elect a student representative to the LCBAS Curriculum Committee at the next meeting of the Dean's Student Advisory Board on September 22, 2004. A student majoring in business served on last year's committee, so the new member must come from the area of technology, family and consumer sciences, or military science. The area the new student represents will follow business on the student representative rotation schedule.

NEW COURSE PROPOSAL – FCS 3794/3784

The new course proposal for FCS 3794 was approved by the LCBAS Curriculum Committee on May 3, 2004. The course was renumbered to FCS 3784 at the request of the Office of the Vice President of Academic Affairs to avoid a conflict with Honors College course numbering.

NEW COURSE PROPOSAL – INT 4953

A new course proposal must have approval from CAA before the President's Council will consider a new course fee request for the course. Course fee requests must be submitted to the Vice President of Academic Affairs by March 1. If the course is approved and the course fee request approved, the fee will generally become effective in the Fall Semester. If the course fee request is not approved, the department may still offer the course, but the department will have to determine how to budget for the course because a fee cannot be collected.

The new course proposal for INT 4953 was approved by CAA on August 26, 2004, and is scheduled to be offered in Spring 2005. The proposal anticipated requesting a course fee. Dr. Izadi may choose to submit a request to the Vice President of Academic Affairs to add a course fee effective for the Fall 2005 semester by February 15, 2005, (corrected DH 9-21-04) but a course fee cannot be added for the Spring 2005 semester.
