## REVIEWING THE WEEK (Nov. 1)

FOOTBALL: NCAA No. 2 ranked Eastern Illinois University knocked off No. 1 ranked Northern Michigan, 35-28, in the ABC-TV regionally televised Division II 'Game of the Week' Saturday. The victory, EIU's sixth straight, boosted the Panthers to 7-2 and almost assured them of the top ranking. QB Jeff Christensen (Gibson City) came off the bench to set EIU records for most passing yardage in a game (370 yards) and most total offense (365) while throwing three TD passes. EIU's defense picked off four passes to tie the season record of 25 pass interceptions.

### MEN'S CROSS

COUNTRY: Led by Perry Edinger (Mattoon) and Larry Schuldt (Rock Falls), EIU qualified for the NCAA II national championship by edging Ferris State, 49-51, for the Great Lakes Regional Saturday. The national championship will be held Saturday, Nov. 15. Edinger and Schuldt were third and fourth, however both were credited with a 31:30 time for the 10,000 meter race. Tim Warneke (Park Forest-Crete/Monee) was 10th, Jase Travis (Bradley-Bourbonnais) was 15th, and Mike Beresford (Danville), 17th. Chuck Elliott (Palatine) and Terry Donahue (Downers Grove-Montini) were 20th and 28th, respectively, but do not count in the scoring. There were 95 runners competing.

### WOMEN'S CROSS

COUNTRY: Eastern was the runnerup in the AIAW II Regional. Marquette won with 35 points followed by the Panthers with 41. Gina Sperry (Litchfield) took fourth in 18:22 over the 3.1 mile course. The winning time was 17:44. Other EIU finishers were Dawn Campbell (Danville-Westville/Danville JC), 5th; Darlene Swank (Joliet-West), 8th; Julie Curry (Highland), 11th; and Janet Steele (Charleston), 13th. EIU advances to the national meet on Saturday, Nov. 15 in Seattle, Washington.
