CHARLESTON, IL--Three choirs will perform at the Eastern Illinois University spring choral concert on Tuesday, April 20 at 8 p.m. in the Dvorak Concert Hall.

Danville High School's Singing Vikings will be the special guest choir. Under the direction of Larry Voorhees, an Eastern graduate, the group will perform "The Last Words of David" and "Ain'a That Good News."

The EIU Chamber Singers, directed by John N. Maharg, will sing two groups of madrigals and spirituals, including works by Verdelot, Lassus, le Jeune, Brahms, Mozart, and a jazz arrangement of "Swing Low, Sweet Chariot."

The EIU Concert Choir, Robert E. Snyder, director, will sing "amazing day" by e.e. cummings, set by Sateren; "The Source of Hope," by Bernard Borah, a member of the choir; and "Exultate justi" by Hakenberger.

Beth Palmer Allen, student conductor, will direct this motet. The spiritual "Hallelujah" by de Cormier will close the program.
