MISSY CAREY RECEIVES AWARD FOR SUSTAINED SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE

CHARLESTON, IL--The Department of Defense recently awarded Charleston native and Eastern Illinois University employee, Missy Carey, with its Sustained Superior Performance award.

The 1973 Eastern graduate is currently a cadet administrator for the U.S. Army Reserve Officers Training Corps (ROTC) program at the University.

Carey is responsible for maintaining computer systems that interface with the Department of Defense, keeping administrative records of more than 120 cadets and preparing payroll and information packets for cadets being commissioned as army
