The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chair Storm.

I. Minutes

The minutes of 4/30/97 were approved as published.

II. Executive Action

1. Chemistry Major (B.S.), Chemistry Concentration — Eliminate "Computer Programming in Chemistry" as a requirement, with a corresponding reduction of 2 semester hours in the hours required in the major and the concentration. Effective date: Fall 1997
2. CHM 3430 — Change course number to 2430. Effective date: Fall 1998
3. CHM 3435 — Change course number to 2435. Effective date: Fall 1998
4. CHM 3840 — Change course number to 2840. Effective date: Fall 1998
5. CHM 3845 — Change course number to 2845. Effective date: Fall 1998
6. CHM Major (M.S.) — Change the number of semester hours for Chemistry 5890 from "5 sem. hrs." to "5-8 sem. hrs.". Effective date: Fall 1997
7. CHM Major (M.S.) — Change the number of semester hours for "Courses chosen from: Chemistry 4760, 4765, 4770, 4790, 4800, 4860, 4900, 4905, 5120, 5200, 5250, 5300, 5400, 5410, 5460" from "15-24 sem. hrs." to "12-21 sem. hrs." Effective date: Fall 1997

III. Proposals

97:21. Proposed Master of Science for Natural Science Teachers.

Dean Wall presented the background for the proposed program to the committee. Dr. Gutowski moved and Dr. Kashefi seconded the motion to approve the proposal.

Mr. McGaughey presented the proposal and answered questions of the committee members. After a lengthy discussion, Dr. Carwell moved and Ms. Smitley seconded the motion to suspend By-Law IV.B.4, to allow immediate voting on the proposal. The motion to suspend the by-law passed unanimously.

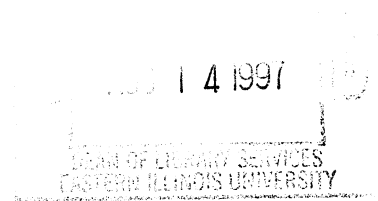
The proposal passed unanimously as amended.
